Elearning

Training courses traditionally offered in a classroom setting are now available through the E-Learning site. This allows users to take training courses online at their convenience and bookmark their place in a course thereby allowing them to return at a later date and complete the course.

Training Validation

The Training Validation application is used to search for a member using the available search options and view their completed training records. Available search options are: (1) directly using a member's MyScouting username or Member ID if they are a registered scouter and (2) using the advanced search criteria by entering any or all of the following fields--Member ID, E-Mail, First Name, Last Name, City, State. Once a single member's record is matched, that member's training records are displayed. The user can also opt to view just the Youth Protection Training courses completed in the last 2 years or all the training courses the user has ever taken.

3. Click on the **eLEARNING tab** on the left menu and then click on the Boy/Varsity Scout tab at the bottom of the page and take 3 internet training courses in the following order:
 - a. This is Scouting
 - b. Fast Start: Boy Scouting
 - c. Youth Protection Training

When you complete each online course please remember to print a copy of your training certificate and present a copy to the Troop Training Coordinator.

 - d. Physical Wellness
 - e. Safe Swim Defense
 - f. Safety Afloat
 - g. Climb On Safely
 - h. Trek Safely
 - i. Weather Hazards

Troop 804 takes great pride in the quality of our adult leadership and recognizes that being a leader in Troop 804 is a privilege and not a right. The quality of our program and the safety of our youth members calls for high-quality trained adult leaders. We work closely with our chartered organization Severn Crossroad Foundation to help recruit the best possible leaders for our Troop.

BSA policy effective June 1, 2010 states that Youth Protection training is required for all BSA registered volunteers, regardless of their position. New leaders are required to take Youth Protection training before submitting an application for registration. The certificate of completion for this training must be submitted at the time the application is made and before volunteer service with youth begins. Youth Protection training must be taken every two years. If a volunteer's Youth Protection training record is not current at the time we recharter the Troop then the volunteer will not be reregistered.
